



## ARATHUSA SAFARI LODGE FACT SHEET 2017

### Location

Arathusa Safari Lodge is located in the northern sector of the world renowned Sabi Sand Private Game Reserve. Millions of unfenced hectares of pristine bushveld offer the discerning guest close and frequent encounters with the African wildlife including the Big 5.

### Accommodation & Facilities

- 9 Water-facing and 4 Bush-facing Suites, each with an en-suite bathroom; outdoor shower; private patio; an open plan lounge and dining area leading onto the patio and swimming pool.  
Dining Room and Outdoor Boma for traditional African dining
- A Safari Spa with a selection of treatments and beauty therapies
- \* *Please note, bush-facing Suites are remotely located and have no view of the waterhole. They do have private plunge pools. Water-facing Suites have a view of the waterhole, but no private plunge pools.*

### How to get there

#### By Road

Nelspruit to Arathusa Safari Lodge – 170 KM (approximately 3 hours by road)  
Hoedspruit to Arathusa Safari Lodge – 80 KM  
(approximately 1.5 to 2 hours by road)  
Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport to Arathusa Safari Lodge -  
165 KM (approximately 3 hours by road)

#### By Air

Daily scheduled flights are available from Johannesburg International Airport to Eastgate Airport (Hoedspruit) on SA Express, and from Skukuza Airport (connecting with scheduled daily flights from/ to Cape Town and Johannesburg) on SA Airlink. Road transfers are available to the lodge. A number of private charter companies operate flights into and out of the region. Please contact us should you require additional information.

To give you an indication of what to expect while on safari at Arathusa, we have provided an outline of what a typical day entails at Arathusa.
