



ARATHUSA SAFARI LODGE FACT SHEET 2019

Location

The enchanting Arathusa Safari Lodge lies within the world renowned Sabi Sand Private Reserve, adjacent to the unfenced Kruger National Park. Guests are treated to an exceptional wildlife experience, including the prized "Big Five".

Accommodation & Facilities

- Thirteen Suites - nine of which face the (now-dry) waterhole* in front of the lodge, and four of which are remotely located within the bush a short distance from the lodge
- Each of the four remote Suites also has its own plunge pool, and affords guests the ultimate privacy
- Each suite has a bathroom en-suite, with shower, as well as a private outdoor shower and verandah. Amenities include a mini bar (stocked with a selection of beverages on request), an electronic safe, hairdryer, air conditioning, direct-dial telephone, mosquito net and tea/ coffee making facilities

- Open-air Dining Room and Outdoor Boma for traditional dining
 - A Safari Spa with a selection of treatments and beauty therapies
- * Despite the devastating drought in the region over the last three years having affected the amount of water in Arathusa's signature waterhole, vast amounts of game still gather on the open plains. We are eagerly anticipating the rains which will hopefully restore the waterhole to its former aquatic glory enjoyed since 1983

How to get there

By Road

Nelspruit to Arathusa Safari Lodge – 170 km (approximately 3 hours by road)
Hoedspruit to Arathusa Safari Lodge – 80 km (approximately 1.5 to 2 hours by road)
Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport to Arathusa Safari Lodge - 165 km (approximately 3 hours by road)

By Air

Daily scheduled flights are available from Johannesburg International Airport to Eastgate Airport (Hoedspruit) on SA Express, and from Skukuza Airport (connecting with scheduled daily flights from/ to Cape Town and Johannesburg) on SA Airlink. Road transfers are available to the lodge. A number of private charter companies operate flights into and out of the region. Please contact us should you require additional information.





A Day at Arathusa
